Dear table tennis community,

New Zealand moved to the Red setting at 11:59pm on 23 January 2022.

The Auckland table tennis stadium is open under the Red setting. The Auckland table tennis stadium is operating from 10.00am to 11.00pm daily with a maximum capacity of 100 persons. Table bookings are on a "first come first served basis". Stadium keyholders must use their personal key in order to turn on lights. As always, stadium keyholders must not let anyone else use their personal key.

The changing rooms and showers are open. The upstairs lounge and cafeteria are closed.

Table hire, private coaching, Central Club, and Auckland Squad training will proceed under the Red setting. Korean Club will resume on Saturday 5th February 2022. We intend to resume the 2021 Winter Interclub competition on Wednesday 2nd February and Thursday 3rd February 2022 however we are still waiting on responses from several teams as to whether they wish to continue competing which impacts the draw.

Under the Red setting the NZCTTA Day Club is closed until further notice, and tournaments with over 100 participants will not proceed.

Children under the age of 12 will be treated as if they have a vaccine pass.

As previously, the conditions of entry before coming to the Auckland table tennis stadium include:

- Stav home if unwell
- You must wear a mask at all times except when being active
- Wash or sanitise hands before entering the facility and when moving through different areas
- Scan the COVID-19 Tracer App QR code every time you enter the facility, or manually record your contact information on forms provided
- · There are no requirements for physical distancing while playing, participating, or spectating
